- If you have been saved it is a result of your response to the Gospel of Jesus Christ.
- <u>Joh 3:16</u> "For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him <u>shall not perish</u>, but have eternal life.
- **2Pe 3:9** The Lord is not slow about His promise, as some count slowness, but is patient toward you, **not wishing for any to perish** but for all to come to repentance.
- Someone told us about this good news and we trusted it, we placed our faith in it and simply because they were faithful to do that, we have been saved from eternal Hell.

#### Truths from the parable.

- Jesus has entrusted us with His greatest position. The Gospel. (14)
- Each one has been entrusted according to our own ability. (15)
- Upon His return we will be held accountable for our faithfulness.(19)
- The reward for those who had been faithful was great. (20-23)
- The failure of those who were not faithful brought judgment. (26-30)
