# Psalm 32

vs 1-2

- Blessed, Approved, Settled, Happy
- Sin forgiven and covered
- Free from judgment and shame



# Psalm 32

vs 3-4

- David's personal experience with being silent about his sin
- Constant agony
- A heavy weight
- A desert land



# Psalm 32

vs 5

- Acknowledge and confess sin
- Confess to the Lord – Forgiveness  
1 John 1:9
- Confess to others – Healing  
James 5:16



# Psalm 32

vs 6-7

- Teach others about God's Mercy
- The value of prayer
- Protection and deliverance



# Psalm 32

vs 8-9

- Hearing the voice of God
- The Spirit, instructs, teaches, and counsels
- He seems distant to the stubborn



# Psalm 32

vs 10

- The wicked or the faithful
- Many sorrows
- Abundant mercy

vs 11

- Be glad and rejoice
- Righteous and upright in heart
