• The American Civil War.... 4 years 498,332 (both sides)

• The Spanish - American War.... 3 years long... 2445 dead

• World War 1 4 years long... 116,516 dead

• World War 2... 6 years long ... 405,399 dead

• Korea ... 3 years long... 54,246 dead

• Vietnam 14 years long... 58,167 dead ; 2,266 MIA

• The Persian Gulf War..... Only @ 20 days.... 293 dead ; 19 MIA

• Iraqi Freedom..... Over 4000 men and women.....KIA
