## Lessons from Paul's letter to Philemon.



- #1 How we extend ourselves on others' behalf should represent Christ in us.

#### Vr. 1-3 Greetings.



- Paul's position, Prisoner!
- · Philemon's position, Brother and fellow worker.
- Other notables.
- Vr. 3 2 powerful truths embedded into this statement.
- #1 Grace Always precedes Peace.
- #2 You will have neither apart from the Father & Son.

# Vr. 4-7 Philemon's testimony of Love and Faith.



- Paul honors Philemon by simply praying for him. Why? "I hear of your Love and your faith."
- That tells us WHY Paul was praying for Him but WHAT was Paul praying for him?
- Vr. 6 that the "fellowship of your faith" becomes effective. "Through the knowledge of truth"
- Vr. 7 Because of Philemon's faith and love, the hearts of the saints were refreshed.

#### Vr.8-9 An Appeal Vs. a Command.



- #1 I could order you to do what is proper!
- **#2 YET FOR LOVES SAKE!**

The real question is not "Am I justified in my response?"

The Real Question is "Is Jesus Glorified in my response?"

Paul said I could command you and make you but I would much rather appeal to your heart and let others see the grace, the love the mercy of Christ flow out of your heart and into the life of another.
