Missing Children Statistics

In 2018 NCMEC assisted law enforcement and families with more than 25,000 cases of missing children.

Case type:

- 92 percent endangered runaways.
- 4 percent family abductions.
- 3 percent critically missing young adults, ages 18 to 20.
- Less than I percent nonfamily abductions.
- I percent lost, injured or otherwise missing children.
- Of the more than 23,500 runaways reported in 2018, one in seven were likely victims of child sex trafficking.
