EXODUS CHAP. 33

VR. 7-11

Moses set up “the tent of Meeting” Out side the camp.

- If we are going to worship God we **MUST** be willing to confess our hearts before Him.
- ***JOH 4:23 ... true worshippers shall worship the Father in spirit and in truth:***

When Moses went to worship, others saw it.

- Those in leadership must take responsibility for setting the example in worship.
- You might say...well, what does that have to do with me?
- YOU are the Spiritual leader in your home and family.

When Moses sought out God's presence , **GOD SHOWED UP !**

- His only desire for worship was to experience the Living God.
- Most folks go to church for what they will get out of it.
