- Yet I was shown.....

Faith for the Faithless Blasphemer.

Grace for the graceless persecutor.

Mercy for the unmerciful violent aggressor.

- All found in Christ Jesus.

An example to follow.



- **Vr 15-17. A trustworthy statement, deserving FULL acceptance.**

Jesus Christ came to save sinners.

I am the worst sinner you will ever meet.

Why would He do this? For His glory.

What's your story? Who are you telling?

Who is God calling you to go to and share your story?

Do you have a story to tell?

P3 Keys..... Obey, Act and Trust...
