- Others were affected by the storm.
- God's servant was AWOL.
- Lives were about to be lost as a result.

Vr. 7-9 Why is this happening to me?

- Whose fault is this.
- What's your story?
- Jonah returns to His faith.

Vr. 10-14 The World is watching. Notice the men's' response......

- "How could you do this?" Vr. 10
- "What should we do?" Vr. 11
- They Called to the LORD. Vr. 14 "let us not perish."

Vr. 15-16 God's wrath and Mercy are seen.

Jonah is suffering for his sin.

There were saved by acting on their faith.

Vr. 17 One amazing fish story.

The Lord appointed that fish to be there.

Jonah was inside that fish for 3 days and 3 nights.
